ORDINANCE NO. 99-5-20

**AN ORDINANCE DEFINING "RESPONSIBLE BIDDER"
FOR THE VILLAGE OF MARK, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes requires the Village of Mark to regulate purchases and contracts entered into by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the definition of "Responsible Bidder" needs to be expanded in the case of bidders for construction projects (construction of new facilities, renovation of current facilities or road construction projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEE OF THE VILLAGE OF MARK, PUTNAM COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Responsible bidder for construction contracts means a bidder who meets all of the following applicable criteria, and submits evidence of such compliance:

- (a) All applicable laws prerequisite to doing business in Illinois;
- (b) Evidence of compliance with (I) a Federal Employer Tax Identification Number or Social Security Number (for individuals); and (II) Provision of Chapter 21; (III) Title 42 of the U.S. Code; and (IV) Federal Executive Order No. 11246 as amended, by Executive Order No. 11375 (known as the Equal Opportunity Employer provisions);
- (c) Certificates of insurance indicating the following coverage: General liability, Workers' Compensation, Completed Operations; Automobile; Hazardous Occupation; Product Liability, and Professional Liability;


- (d) Compliance with all provisions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, including wages, medical and hospitalization insurance and retirement for those trades as covered in the Act; and
- (e) Participation in apprenticeship and training programs approved and registered with the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein hereby adopted shall be construed to reduce any right or obligation provided or protected by federal or state law, or local law. Nor shall this ordinance affect any right or will any remedy be lost or impaired by this ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

PRESENTED, PASSED, AND ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Mark, Illinois, by an aye and nay roll call vote, with 6 voting aye, 0 voting nay, 0 absent, and Village President Kevin J. Troglia voting, which meeting was held on the 20th day of May, 1999.
