RESOLUTION NO. 03-11-24-3

Resolution  
(Responsible bidder)

WHEREAS, Section 85-30 of the Township Code regulates purchases and contracts entered into by the Township; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to define "responsible bidder" in the case of bidders for construction projects (construction of new facilities, renovation of current facilities)

over \$ 5,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Town Trustees of Long Creek Township, Macon County, Illinois that the following definitions be used in determining responsible bidders under the terms of Section 85-30 of the Township Code.

"Responsible bidder" for construction contracts (over \$ 5,000.00)

means a bidder who meets all of the following applicable criteria, and submits evidence of such compliance:

- (1) All applicable laws prerequisite to doing business in Illinois.
- (2) Evidence of compliance with
  - (a) Federal Employer Tax Identification Number or Social Security Number (for individuals).
  - (b) Provisions of Section 2000 (e) of Chapter 21, Title 42 of the United States Code and Federal Executive Order No. 11246 as amended by Executive Order No. 11375 (known as the Equal Opportunity Employer provisions).

- (3) Evidence of Insurance indicating the following coverages:  
general liability, worker's compensation, completed operations,  
automobile, hazardous occupation, product liability, and  
professional liability.
- (4) Compliance with all applicable provisions of the Illinois  
Prevailing Wage Act, including wages, medical and  
hospitalization insurance and retirement for those trades as  
covered in the Act.
- (5) Participation in apprenticeship and training programs approved  
and registered with the United States Department of Labor's  
Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that nothing herein hereby adopted shall be construed  
to affect any suit or proceeding now pending in any court or any rights accrued or liability  
incurred or cause or causes of action accrued or existing under any prior Resolution or Ordinance.  
Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect  
immediately upon its adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this Board is hereby authorized and  
directed to prepare and deliver a certified copy of this Resolution to the Supervisor of the  
Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any term, condition or provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall, to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Resolution or the application of such term or provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid or unenforceable shall not be affected thereby, and such terms, conditions and provisions of this Resolution shall be valid and be enforced to the fullest extent provided by law.
